Explore island culture

Let us take you on a short journey to explore our local neighbors. This is a great opportunity to see the daily life in these communities.

Meedhoo is urbanizing fast but the community is preserving historic monuments such as the old Friday mosque which is believed to be over 200 years old. This mosque still exhibits the original building, wood carving and carpentry techniques.





Fainu still retains many elements of traditional Maldivian island life. The community still engage in organic and biodynamic farming in two monsoonal cycles every year. Their main produce is water melons which they supply to the resorts and to the rest of Maldives in Ramadan every year.

Take a stroll along the main roads and pathways to witness the sights and sounds of the island. Experience the island vibe; you are likely to see women preparing and cooking food under the shade of trees in their front and backyards, men fishing and children playing outdoors in groups.
